#### **Speaker: Keith Johnson**

Keith Johnson has served in LOM for 37 years in Minnesota, California and now in North Carolina, which serves seven states and four synods in the southeast. Lake of the Woods Bible Camp was a small camp in northern Minnesota that Keith directed while at Wartburg Seminary. Camp Vermilion was a regional camp that served two conferences of the old Northern Minnesota District of the ALC. Lutheran Retreats Camps and Conferences in Southern California served two synods of the ELCA, with a focus on merging two camps (Yolijwa and El Camino Pines) following the formation of the ELCA. LLMI focus has been on re-developing Lutheridge Conference Center and Camp, developing Camp Lutherock site and program, acquiring Lutheranch site, and now managing Luther Springs in Florida.



#### **Worship Leader: Tim Hansen**

Tim Hansen has served as the Sr. Pastor of St. Stephen's Lutheran Church in Monona, WI, since 2008. Having served twenty-five years in ordained ministry, Hansen understands the rhythm of worship in the life of the church. He has also been involved in camping ministry throughout the church, having served on the Green Lake Lutheran Ministries board in Spicer, MN, and currently serving on the Lutherdale board at Elkhorn, WI. Music has been an important part of his faith and life within and without his ministry. He formed the Tim Hansen Project in 1993 and has continued to raise money for hunger and relief projects through recordings and concerts.



#### **Spiritual Director: Jack Finney**

Pastor Jack Finney has served four ELCA congregations in Illinois over a 34-year period. In 1999 he left parish ministry to begin Living Waters, a specialized ministry that includes adult forums, retreats, and spiritual direction. Jack and his wife, Jan, moved to Stoughton, WI in August of 2008 so they could be near family and he continues to offer this ministry in the greater Madison, WI area. Jack holds a certificate for spiritual direction from the Shalem Institute.
