## 2024 Annual Report of the LOM President

Our work this year has been centered on the strategic plan. But a majority of what has been accomplished has come from the needs of our outdoor ministries organizations and their staff who are involved in this organization.

This has been a very busy year for LOM. The following is a short list of our work together.

Major LOM accomplishments for 2024:

- Began a complete rebranding of LOM including a fresh new logo, working in partnership with Tic-Tac-Toe
- Continued to work with a creative and active development committee to develop a strong financial development plan for LOM
- Approved an updated LOM Gift Acceptance Policy, thanks to the work of the development Committee
- In the process of a major LOM by-laws review and revision to make them more relevant and so they match our current practices
- Developed and are implementing the LOM Community Expectations policy for all LOM events to ensure all feel safe and included
- Played a major role in the planning for the 2025 OMC Great Gathering
- Produced another outstanding summer curriculum

- Finalized the ELCA Outdoor Ministry Affiliation Criteria document and submitted it to church-wide council for approval

- Fully lived into our purpose as LOM by providing support to Red Willow Ministries and Park River Bible Camp, as well as Bear Creek Lutheran Camp. Thank you to Don for taking the lead on our behalf
- Continued efforts to create a more welcoming greeting and presence at the annual conference

One other major accomplishment from this year is the LOM Board had a lengthy and heart-felt conversation of why LOM exists. There are parts of the strategic plan that would lead us to focus our energies on expanding our presence so the world knows Lutheran Outdoor Ministries.
