While each of us may not possess all the necessary tools or cultural awareness to engage in the most inclusive language or behaviors, it is the responsibility of leaders facilitating each Leadership Training Event, LTE, to cultivate an open and inclusive atmosphere. Participants in LTE activities are expected to cooperate in creating such an environment. However, if language or behavior is used that does not contribute to this goal, steps will be taken to address and restore the situation.

As we grow and learn we will support and foster all people, we know that listening and responding to the reporter of an incident is critical to reconciliation. We recognize that this deeper sense of community means learning, forgiveness, and humility. Becoming a more trusting community means living through accountability and reconciliation. The LTE leadership team is responsible for facilitating the reconciliation process that restores the gathered participants to a whole community where all feel welcomed and encouraged to participate without barriers.
